Apply now to be a member of a Town of Stratford committee and make a difference in our Town. *All* Stratford residents are eligible and no previous experience is required. Whether you are a current committee member, or are applying for the first time, please complete this application by 12 noon on October 26, 2018. The next term is from December 1, 2018 to November 30, 2020. The commitment consists of one meeting per month for standing committees while sub-committees may have special projects or events that require additional time which varies throughout the year. In 2016 the Town of Stratford established a Committee Appointment Policy to better help ensure that our Town committees are representative of the broader community and that all perspectives are considered as much as possible.
